Neurodiverse Communities for Individuals and Families

EvoLibri Consulting hosts a variety of social and support groups for neurodiverse individuals and families in an effort to create ongoing communities for friendship and support. We invite interested parties to contact us for more information.

↳ Club Neuro/Nitro

Clubs Neuro and Nitro are our flagship social groups for neurodiverse teens ages 14-20. We meet an average of five times a month – three times on Friday evenings (Club Neuro), and two Saturdays a month around noon (Club Nitro). Club Neuro meets at our office in Sunnyvale for pizza, board games, art, movies, video games, and other teenage-friendly indoor activities. Club Nitro meets at a local venue for outdoor/offsite activities such as laser tag, mini golf, geocaching, or bowling. Cost for each event is \$35, and members must be prescreened prior to attending an event. Visit www.meetup.com/clubneuro for our calendar and contact us at info@evolibri.com for a free intake. ↳ Club Engaged

Club Engaged is our 'grownup' counterpart to Club Neuro and is for young adults (typically college bound or in college) ages 19-26. We meet once a month on a Friday evening, and may also host additional events as we can. We typically play a complex strategy game such as Settlers of Catan, and have Gumba's pizza. ↳ Club X

Club X is our support group for adults with Asperger's Syndrome. We meet once a month on a Sunday evening for a potluck dinner for conversation, support, and occasionally a guest speaker. This is a very informal group, and new members may sign up through our Meetup calendar at www.meetup.com/ClubXAspies.

↳ Parenting Beyond 18

On the first Friday of the month, EvoLibri sponsors an informal support group of parents who have (or will have) adult children who will need ongoing support beyond 18. This meeting occurs at the same time as our first Club Neuro of the month, and we generally meet at a restaurant within walking distance of our Sunnyvale office. Sign up at www.meetup.com/EvoLibri.

↳ EvoLibri Special Events

We occasionally sponsor special events through the year such as screenings of documentaries and movies, informational talks by attorneys specializing in special needs trusts or education, yoga classes, RDI, and other topics. We generally post these on all Meetup calendars.

Using Meetup.com

EvoLibri uses Meetup.com to schedule and publicize all of our events. This is the simplest, most cost-effective way of communicating with our communities. In order to use Meetup, you must first create a free account on the site. Simply go to www.meetup.com, and click register. Once you have an account, you can access our various sites. Note that for Club Neuro events, we must approve your membership, which may take a few days. We do this to ensure that no predators have access to our youth groups.

Notes Regarding Clubs Neuro/Nitro/Engaged

- **Club Neuro Gold Membership** – All CN events are \$35 at the door, which covers the cost of the food/snacks/beverages, the cost of our staff's wages, and our overhead. Families with teens who come to many events may choose to purchase a **Gold Membership for \$200** – each event then costs \$20 at the door, which will save 'frequent flyers' between \$100 and \$300 a year. Gold Memberships are available year-round and are prorated by the calendar year.
- **Financial Hardship** – if your family is low income or on a fixed income, we will be happy to consider this a hardship, and will waive the \$200 membership fee, reducing the cost of events to \$20. This is on a case-by-case basis, and you must contact us in advance to discuss.
- **Club Neuro Rules** – We do our best to ensure that all club members feel safe, comfortable, and respected during our events. To that end, all members are required to act respectfully to staff and other members at all times, and must follow staff's requests as needed. Failure to do so, or to continually disrupt the group, will cause members to be asked to leave immediately and to be given a 'strike'. Members who receive three strikes in three months will be expelled for no less than three months to correct the behavior. If after this expulsion the member continues the disruptive behavior, s/he may be permanently barred.
